WINTER PANSIES

Winter pansies are those that have been started from seed in the summer. They are young and strong enough to live through the winter. Pansies prefer cool weather, especially cool nights. They will bloom through the fall and possibly during warm spells in the winter. They will also bloom for you when it warms up next spring. Plant them in a place where they will get full sun or partial shade. Space plants about 6 inches apart and mulch around them. Make sure they don't dry out the first week or so, after that you should only need to water if it doesn't rain or snow for 5 straight days. Fertilize every two weeks while they are growing in the fall and the next spring. Pick off the spent flowers to induce more blooms.
